Esher - Morning

A mild start to the day with light winds. Very humid. Skies may be overcast at the Starting Line but should soon brighten-up.

0700	15 C	59 F
0900	20 C	64 F

En route to Hove - 7am until 3pm

Turning increasingly sunny. A small chance of a few showers at any stage during the ride, especially over the hills. Should any showers occur watch out for slippery surfaces after the recent dry spell! Temperatures may peak at 25C/77F.

To sum-up, for most cyclists it'll be a dry but very humid ride!

Brighton and Hove - Morning and Afternoon

Generally sunny with light winds. Very warm. Showers are unlikely at the Finishing Line or on the immediate approach.
